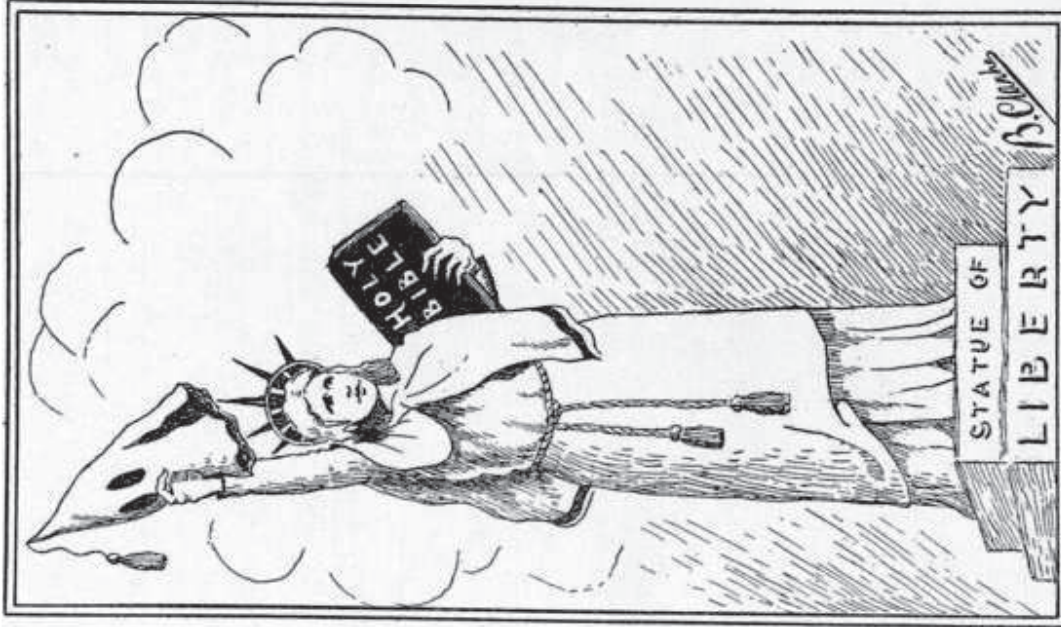

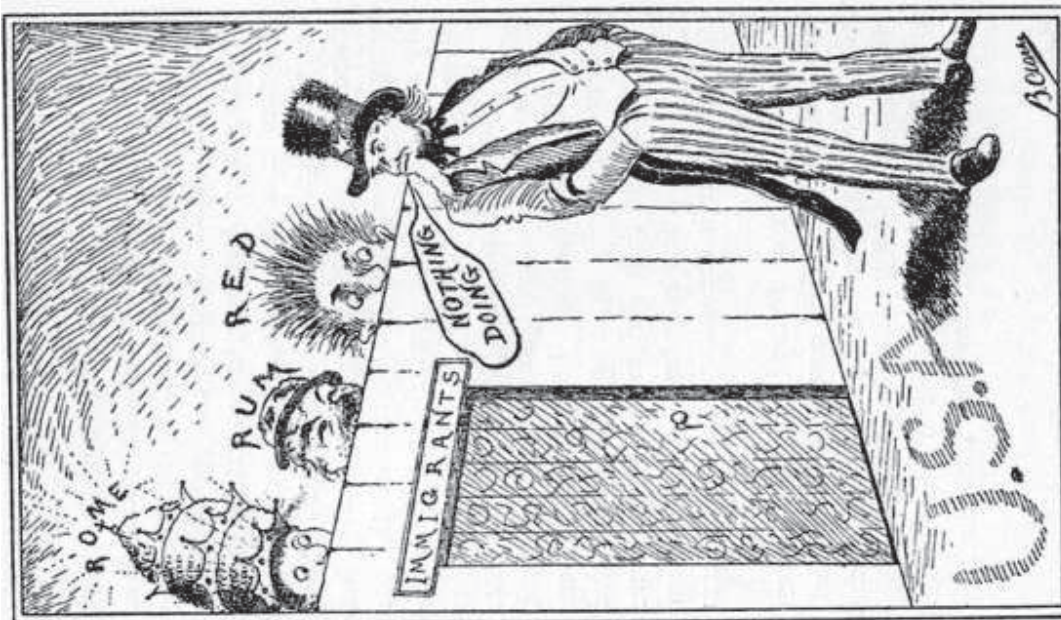
“Uncle Sam: ‘We Don’t Need You in the U.S.’”
